>>> Apply for the Harbor Freight Tools for Schools Prize for Teacher Excellence

Applications are now open for the <u>Harbor Freight Tools for Schools Prize for Teaching Excellence</u>. The prize recognizes outstanding instruction in the skilled trades in U.S. public high schools and the teachers who inspire students to learn skills to prepare for life after graduation. In 2025, Harbor Freight will award \$1.5 million in cash prizes to 25 skilled trades teachers and their programs. In 2024, the prize recognized 12 SkillsUSA instructors as winners. Applications must be received by **May 2**. Finalists will be announced June 10 and winners will be announced this fall.

At the 2025 National Leadership & Skills Conference (NLSC), SkillsUSA will recognize advisors, students and registered alumni for their community service through the President's Volunteer Service Award (PVSA).
